California Snowball Viburnum

EARLY SEASON: Soft yellow-green snowball-like clusters form delightful tennis ball size pompoms of tiny blossoms on tall, woody, leafy stems.

LATE SEASON: Blooms mature to luxurious ivory color superfilled masses.

LENGTH: Branches to 30". Standard bunch size: 10 stems. Also available as Consumer Bunches.

DISPLAY: The billowy blooms—even with their brief season—are a favorite for wedding and high-end floral design.

FARM FRESH: Sun Valley Viburnum is grown in an inland mountain canyon where the micro-climate provides a prime location to produce this fantastic spring show.

CARE AND HANDLING: Upon arrival cut stems and place into a clean container with fresh, tepid water and fresh flower food solution. Remove all foliage below the water line. Keep in cool location out of direct sunlight and drafts. Replenish water as needed. If you do not add floral preservative, change the water and re-cut the stems every day or so.

- Viburnum blooms are often mistaken for a miniature hydrangea.
- Native to the Northern Hemisphere, the Viburnum also prospers in the mountainous regions of Africa, south-east Asia and South America.
- Viburnum is a genus of about 150-175 species of shrubs or (in a few species) small trees that have been newly classified in the family Adoxaceae.
